Notes

Minor changes were made to this fee schedule to include a 3% CPI adjustment and to clarify the fee categories and how services will be charged. Associated onshore site visit costs were not previously charged but should have been reimbursed based on APAC's Rules for Accreditation. No new fees have been introduced in this schedule.

1. Level refers to the graduate competency level:
 - a. *Level 1 Foundational Competencies*
 - b. *Level 2 Pre-Professional Competencies*
 - c. *Level 3 Professional Competencies*
 - d. *Level 4 Professional Competencies for Specialised Areas of Practice*
2. Program sequence is defined as a recognised set of units of study in psychology and the rules governing their completion including the order in which they must be undertaken. The assessment of identical program sequences is only charged once. Other services, such as additional program titles incur a separate fee.
3. Level 1 undergraduate sequence assessment fee (including undergraduate bridging program) is charged only once where the sequence is identical, for example the assessment of the identical Level 1 sequence within six different undergraduate degree program titles results in one fee.
4. Level 2 sequence assessment fee is charged once for Honours programs where the program is identical, and once for Graduate Diploma programs where the program is identical, for example the assessment of the identical Level 2 sequence within six different Honours degree program titles results in one fee.
5. Packaged Level 1 and 2 undergraduate sequence assessment fee (including undergraduate bridging program) is charged only once where the sequence is identical, for example the assessment of the identical packaged Level 1 and 2 sequence within six different undergraduate degree program titles results in one fee.
6. For all physical site visits, if required, providers are required to directly bear the full cost of economy travel (except offshore and travel of over 3 hours which will incur premium economy fares, or business fares where premium economy is not available), accommodation, transfers, meals and travel time for all assessment team members. A reviewed site visit model will reduce the financial impact of site visits while ensuring the accreditation processes' effectiveness.
